Discussion of replacing the fencing along creek. Thought to add a 2 foot piece of sheet metal along the bottom.

Clubhouse kitchen: Baffles above stove need to be cleaned. Refrigerator door gaskets need replacement. Dan will replace these.

Need to purchase a computer to use for PSF business. The Soper's have used their own for all these years. Storage closet located on side of stage where liquor was once storage can be converted into office space. Will inquire with member Burr Wilson regarding set up of wireless.

Clubhouse Committee: Reappointed of Dan Coville. Joe Turner has been working for YEARS fulfilling whatever PSF needs. He needs a break. We cannot thank him enough for all the hours he has contributed to the organization.

Motion approved to purchase a color printer for Bev Palm for contracts. About half of the type on the contract is red. Cost approx. \$150.00 (Again, these contracts had been printed on the Soper's personal printer.)

Motion approved to purchase an ice machine for the clubhouse. Joe Pedroni has access to one part of the equipment (this is a two-piece unit), which will save us money. Ice will still need to be purchase for our larger events.

Motion approved to rent back the field, now owned by Dave Tarca, to secure overflow parking needed for all PSF events, and outside renters in the amount of \$1,250.00 per year. Without this parking, we would not be able to accommodate the overflow of cars.

John, Darrell & Eric S. will replace several picnic tables at the park, labor free. PSF will cover the cost of the lumber.

Tractors still under repair.
