

He and his wife had a dairy on the corner of Petaluma Hill Road and East Railroad Ave. Leo, in my opinion, was one of the most dedicated members for over 4 decades. He helped raise money for the two parcels now known as Penngrove Park.

There were a few years where our finances were lacking and we needed help paying the property taxes; Leo helped carry us through these times by offering no interest loans which were always paid after the July BBQ. Very few people knew that Leo did this and that's the way he wanted it. Dedication to work and financial aid were paramount to him. Above all, he loved the Penngrove Social Firemen until his last days on this earth. Thank you, Leo, for everything you did for P.S.F. I, among others, share a concern that members of today need to know that the birth of the P.S.F. was accomplished by a group of dedicated, hard-working people from Penngrove, and we should never lose sight of their unselfish acts of kindness.
