

This has become a big event. Please follow all the rules on the application and be careful on the road.

We have increased the CHP help and will have several lighted message boards on Old Redwood Hwy warning motorists of the event and pedestrians' presence.

With the darkness of the evening, we are trying to make this as safe as possible for everyone.

If you are planning on leaving the parade after cruising down Main St., headed home, and leaving the parade route, please note the same vehicle rules apply; (a) No person driving a pickup truck or a flatbed motortruck on a highway shall transport any person in or on the back of the truck. (b) No person shall ride in or on the back of a truck or flatbed motortruck being driven on a highway.

If this is your first time, please be early as it gets very congested in the park. If you have people who will be part of your entry, and drive separately to meet up with you, they must park outside the park and walk in. There is NO public parking in the park, unlike when we have public parking for the July Parade. Once you are in the park, there is no turning around.

If you are with more than one group and wish to be together, you must come together. There is no line up sequence. First in, first out. Due to the size of some of the units please move up as close to each other as possible. Please also try to stay to the right of the road to allow people to walk and any emergency vehicles to get through.

There will be attendants walking around to check you in. This is for the purpose of being sure we have your signed application.

Overflow entries will be directed into The Grove parking lot which is directly across the street from the park. If that gets full, then we move you onto Old Redwood and Main St.

This is a very exciting, but hectic evening. We do our best to line up everyone in order.

Please remember there is NO throwing candy or the like from your unit. It is OK to pass them out while walking along side. It is too dark, and the littles are too small and may not be seen by the drivers of the big rigs.

If you wish to get in earlier and decorate that's fine.
