Our Corned Beef and Cabbage went well. We served 302 dinners. Our net profit was \$ 2600.00 less the reusable advertising banners of \$ 380.00. The banners can be used in future years with only the date being change at a cost of \$ 50.00. Stan Pronzini was chairperson of this event along with his crew that did an excellent job in ordering, cooking and serving.

Moving forward, the Board of Directors decided that non-members with questions or issues can be scheduled on the Board of Directors meeting which is always the first Monday following our regular meeting (unless rescheduled). Following the regular meeting there will be directors available that will be happy to meet with non-members and members alike. If the concerns are lengthy then we will schedule a time for your concerns at the following directors meeting. An agenda will be scheduled and members and non-members will be first. After all concerns are addressed the board will go into an executive session (Board Members Only). Of course all verbal or written transactions will be in the minutes and published in the following Gazette.

The Board had unanimously voted in 2011 to reduce some of the events during the year that deemed to be below our reasonable profit level as well as reduce the number of events requiring volunteer time. We felt we were asking people to participate in 9 to 10 events a year was excessive and especially when the same people that help are there for every event. We had also decided to focus more energy on those events that generate at minimum of \$ 2500.00 and more.

To offset some of the work load the Board unanimously voted to cancel the April breakfast and donate \$ 2000.00 to the school as we had in past years keeping us compliant with our non-profit status. Penngrove Social Firemen Directors Meeting March 12, 2012

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Ray. Those present: Kim Hanson, Scott Thurston, Al Davidson, Ray Soper, Dean DeGraffenreid, Bill Park, Roland Mellor, Ed Grossi and Joe Turner. Directors absent: John Rossi & Stan Pronzini.

President Ray asked Ed Grossi to tell about making sound better in large meeting hall at PSF Club House. Ed's source of information comes from "sound expert" friend. Walls could be furred out w/2"x2" lumber for insulation fill and existing benches on either side of hall, backs and seats lined with some type of soft material, for insulation value and comfort. Ceiling is fine as is with "popcorn" finish and floors can remain as is. Ed Grossi will get more information and costs at later date. It was estimated to do the above work would cost approximately \$2000.00 to \$5000.00. Truckers Ball regenerated tonight. President Ray gave a brief history on how and when Truckers Ball started- all the people have passed on that started the program. The program was restored in the 1970's. There will be a Truckers Ball on May 12, 2012. Roland Mellor is leading the program, Roland asked Kim to procure liquor license. 




