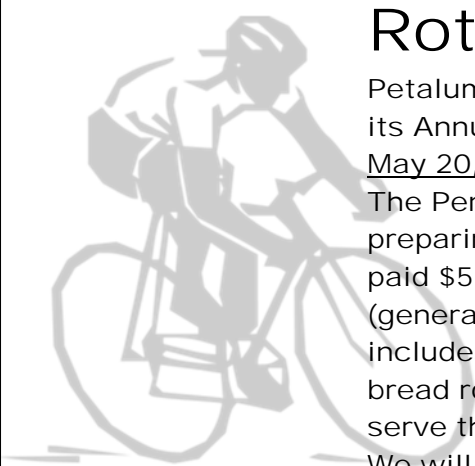

Penngrove Social Firemen Board Meeting – Monday, April 17, 2017

Meeting was held at Ray Soper's and came to order at 6:10 p.m.

Guests: Bruce Linscott and Tim Henry from the RAFD, Martin Sessi

Bruce and Tim were here to discuss the use of the pantry for their annual Crab Feed. There had been a misunderstanding that the pantry was available for their use. Ray advised that last year, in 2015, they, the RAFD, were told they could no longer have use of any items in the pantry. This message was never passed on to the new crew for 2016. It's been the policy of PSF since 2015 that anyone who rents the clubhouse no longer has use of the pantry or dishware due to items missing and the expense of having to replace such items. This is not to say that the missing items were due to the RAFD. Items have been missing, in general, from the use of renters. The RAFD understands this now and will make note to all at the fire house. RAFD will continue their same relationship with the PSF.

Martin came to discuss the replacement of the good neighbor fence at the park. This fence needs replacement from years of weather. He has requested 15-16 ft inside for a total of approx. 100 ft along the front park to be used for additional parking. He will pay for the paving and to replace the fence completely. He is not looking for any ownership of the park. The Directors will discuss further and make their decision later. Directors and Patty discussed the upcoming parade, duties, and costs.

Scott suggested that the vent screens located in the kitchen and bathrooms be covered up to eliminate mud coming into these rooms during heavy rains/flooding. Redwood Fence Co. will give us a bid to replace the fencing in several areas of the park.
